THE KITION BURSARY SCHEME

The Kition Bursary Scheme is designed to offer students for courses offered by the Cyprus College of Art some assistance with the cost of their fees whilst they are studying at the Cyprus College of Art.

General Criteria

The bursary scheme is run on a competitive basis and all applicants should be aware that the maximum bursary offered will be 50% of the course fee in any one year. It most cases any bursary offered is likely to be less than 50% of the course fee. Be aware that not all applicants who apply will be successful. Early applicants are more likely to receive bursary funding than later ones.

Where a bursary is awarded it will be paid directly to the Cyprus College of Art in the form of a part-fee waiver. It will only be available for Cyprus College of Art programmes and any bursary offered will not be transferable to another course, or another person, or another institution, or to another academic year.

Only the following Cyprus College of Art programmes qualify for bursaries under the Kition Bursary Scheme:

- The Foundation Award in Art and Design
- The Associate Fellowship in Fine Art
- The Postgraduate Diploma in Fine Art

Only full-time study is eligible for Bursary Scheme assistance. No assistance is available for part-time study.

Where a programme lasts more than one year a new application for assistance under the Kition Bursary Scheme must be submitted annually, by the relevant deadline, and applicants should be aware that a successful application to the scheme in one year does not indicate that applications in subsequent years will be successful.

Decision Process

Once we have received your Kition Bursary application form we will cross reference this with your course application form. Using this information, statements from your referees and, if appropriate, information from any interview you might have attended, the College will make a decision on (a) the number of bursaries to award; (b) the amount of each bursary; (c) the applicants chosen to receive bursaries.

How to Apply

To apply for the Kition Bursary Scheme you must submit an application form to the Cyprus College of Art for an appropriate course or programme taught at the Cyprus College of Art and a bursary application form. You can submit the course and bursary applications at the same time, or you can submit the course application form first and the bursary form later.

The last date for the submission of applications for the Bursary Scheme is <u>I July 2009</u> for courses starting in the Autumn 2009. Late applications will not be considered.
