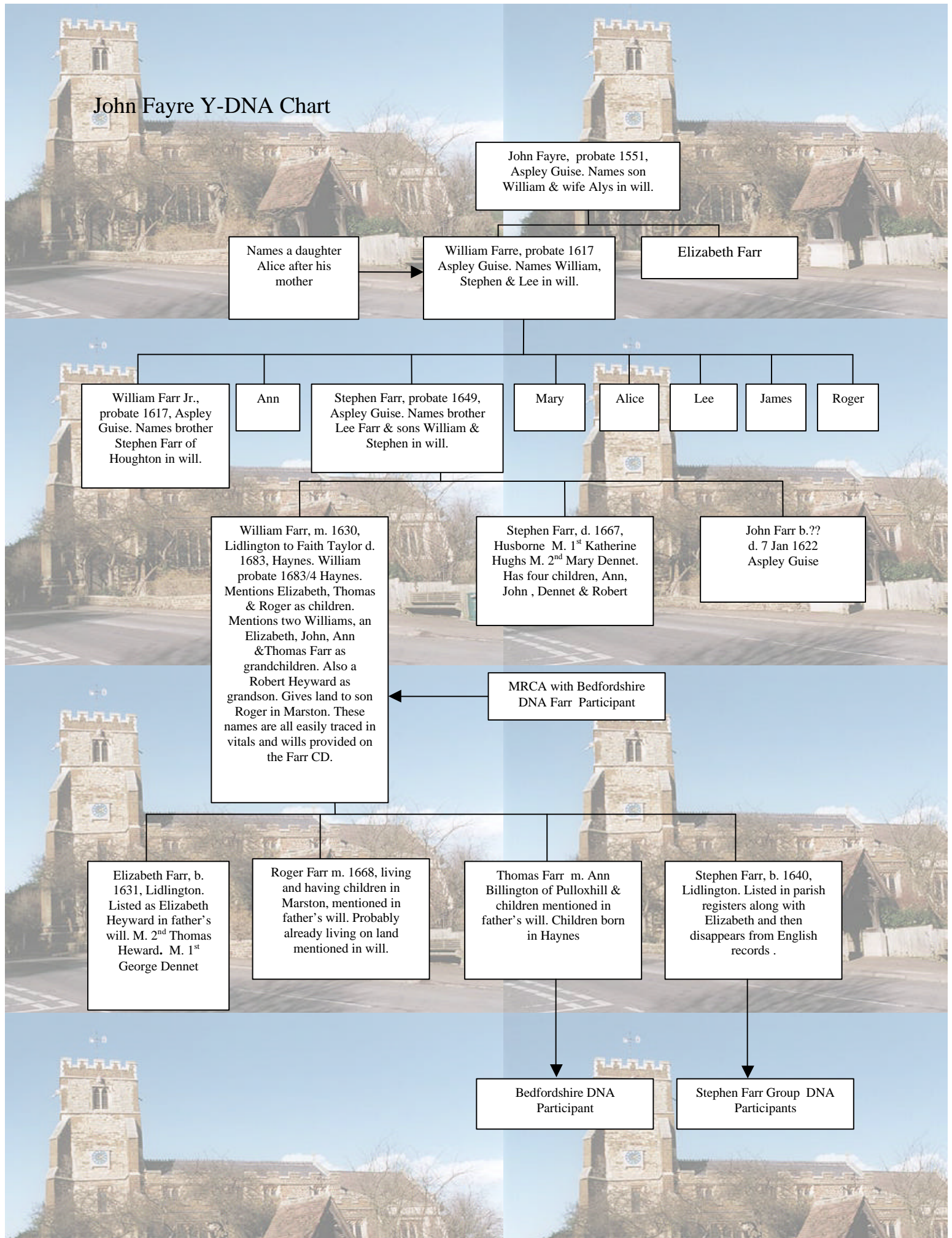


# John Fayre Y-DNA Chart



John Fayre, probate 1551, Aspley Guise. Names son William & wife Alys in will.

Names a daughter Alice after his mother

William Farre, probate 1617 Aspley Guise. Names William, Stephen & Lee in will.

William Farr Jr., probate 1617, Aspley Guise. Names brother Stephen Farr of Houghton in will.

Stephen Farr, probate 1649, Aspley Guise. Names brother Lee Farr & sons William & Stephen in will.

William Farr, m. 1630, Lidlington to Faith Taylor d. 1683, Haynes. William probate 1683/4 Haynes. Mentions Elizabeth, Thomas & Roger as children. Mentions two Williams, an Elizabeth, John, Ann & Thomas Farr as grandchildren. Also a Robert Heyward as grandson. Gives land to son Roger in Marston. These names are all easily traced in vitals and wills provided on the Farr CD.

Stephen Farr, d. 1667, Husborne M. 1st Katherine Hughs M. 2nd Mary Dennet. Has four children, Ann, John, Dennet & Robert

John Farr b.?? d. 7 Jan 1622 Aspley Guise

MRCA with Bedfordshire DNA Farr Participant

Elizabeth Farr, b. 1631, Lidlington. Listed as Elizabeth Heyward in father's will. M. 2nd Thomas Heward. M. 1st George Dennet

Roger Farr m. 1668, living and having children in Marston, mentioned in father's will. Probably already living on land mentioned in will.

Thomas Farr m. Ann Billington of Pulloxhill & children mentioned in father's will. Children born in Haynes

Stephen Farr, b. 1640, Lidlington. Listed in parish registers along with Elizabeth and then disappears from English records .
