

## God is not Mad at you – Part 001

Rom 5:1-11 - Being therefore justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ; v2 through whom also we have had our access by faith into this grace wherein we stand; and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God. v3 And not only so, but we also rejoice in our tribulations: knowing that tribulation worketh stedfastness; v4 and stedfastness, approvedness; and approvedness, hope: v5 and hope putteth not to shame; because the love of God hath been shed abroad in our hearts through the Holy Spirit which was given unto us. v6 For while we were yet weak, in due season Christ died for the ungodly. v7 For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: for peradventure for the good man some one would even dare to die. v8 But God commendeth his own love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. v9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, shall we be saved from the wrath of God through him. v10 For if, while we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, shall we be saved by his life; v11 and not only so, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

### A short History

- At the foundation of the world God had a plan for Salvation for us His creation.
- The war in God's kingdom and Satan and a third of his angles
- God prepares Hell for the Devil and his angels and half of these fallen angels are cast into hell – 2 Peter 2:4.
- Satan and the other half of his angels are thrown out of the world and given authority on earth.
- When God created this world, He created it perfect. God created man to live eternally
- However, man sinned and missed Gods mark for mankind.
- God is all loving God but He is also all Righteous. His righteousness cannot tolerate any sin. So He punishes mad but banishing him from the garden and the curses on the ground, women etc.
- The world is evil, the fallen angels are having relations with the women of the world and God decides to destroy the whole world in a flood but spares the lives of Noah and his family
- After the ark, God makes a covenant with Abraham and gives him the land of Israel.
- The slavery of Egypt and God freeing the people of Israel, through Moses. He gives Moses the 10 commandments and other things like the temple layout etc.
- Moses dies and Joshua takes over and Israel enters the Promised Land.
- The time of the Judges and Kings of Israel.
- The 70 years of Babylonian captivity.
- Rebuilding of the walls and temple of Jerusalem
- The Inter Testament period – The Alexander the great, Macabeeds, the Romans.
- JESUS Born and live on earth for 33 years and is crucified, and dies for our sins.
- JESUS descends into hell, ministers to the spirits there, and takes back the keys of death form Satan. – 1 Peter
- Jesus arises from the dead and walks the earth for 40 days and then ascends to heaven
- The early church with Paul's ministry starting. Jerusalem is destroyed in 70 AD
- Dark ages – Bibles are withheld from the people and Christianity recognized as the religion of Rome.
- The start of the Roman Catholic Church. In addition, most of today's religious dogmas. These were designed to ensnare people until this day.
- Middle ages, many wars and the 8 crusades where Jews are murdered if they do not convert and the Spanish Inquisition where Jews bones are dug up and "trails held" and eventually their land is reposed by the church.
- Reformation - Martin Luther starts the protestant movement, many people killed by the Catholic Church in the name of "Religion". Also the start of the printing press by Guttenberg.
- The bible translated into English by William Tyndale, who is martyred but King James recognized Tyndale's the bible and each English man can read God's word in his own language.
- The church continues to develop and in the later 1800, revivals start to spring up all over the world, like South Africa, Azusa Street in California and all over America.
- The start after the 2<sup>nd</sup> world war of the large ministries, the "big names" in our day. Like Catharine Kulman, Oral Roberts, Billy Graham, James Robson and later US
