1. GEORGE MILTON (MILTON WATSON (JOFT BROWN3, JOEL BROWN2, W. JAMESI) was born October 08, 1876 in Collin County, Texas, USA, and died October 10, 1922 in Collin County, Texas, USA. He married OLIVE (OLLIE3 AUDREE BACK] Abt. 1903 in Probably Collin County, Texas, USA, daughter of JOHN BACK and EMMA BRITTON.

Notes for GEORGE MILTON (MILT) WATSON: George Milton Watson was the fifth of twelve children born to Joel Brown Watson and Elizabeth Jane Smith on October 8th, 1876. He was called Milt by his family and PaPa by his children. The Watson Family had moved to Collin County from Cumberland County, Kentucky in the mid-1800's so it assumed that George Milton was born in Collin County. The family owned a 160 acre farm near the community of Weston and attended school at Kelly. His father was an evangelist amd was gone much of the time. Thus the cotton crops were planted and harvested by the sons and daughters. George Milton was grew up in a typical farming community who depended on cotton for a cash crop, vegetable gardens and orchards to feed a large family. He married Olive Audree Back in 1903 and moved to the Texas Panhandle in 1904 with the Back Family. There were ten children born to this union. He and Ollie were farmers and helped the Back's establish a foothold in this new land in Gray County. The community is known today as Back Community. Grandma Watson called them back to Collin County in 1910 to help on the family farm. The Back and Watson farms were side by side in Collin County and good neighbors. George Milton was a farmer and also noted as an expert trader of horses and cattle. He always drove the latest model automobile and it is said that he bought Ollie the first washing machine to be delivered in Collin County. The washer was purchased at the Texas State Fair in Dallas. My dad, Lawrence Mitchel, Sr. told me about a trip he made with his dad in the summer of 1922. Lawrence was 16 years old at the time and PaPa let him drive to Mineral Wells. The trip was eventful as there were few roads in those days and a rough ride was in store, whether you were in a wagon or automobile. Lawrence got to close to a tree on the way and knocked a rear view mirror completely off the car; PaPa didn't say a word to his son, just shook his head. They stayed at the Baker Hotel in Mineral Wells, where Milt took baths to help ease the pain of his colon cancer, that would claim his life later than year. He died October 10, 1922 and is buried at Warden Cemetery near the community of Weston. (L. M. Watson, Jr. 1999)

Notes for OLIVE (OLLTE3 AUDREE BACK: Olive (Ollie) Audree Back was the firstborn of ten children to John David Back and Emma Vaugh Britton. The Backs homestead was 160 acres of generally level black clay soil in Collin County, Texas. Cotton was their primary cash crop, farmed with horses and mules. A vegetable garden was planted in the spring to help feed the large family. Cows were milked twice a day for fresh milk and butter. Corn fed beeves were killed in the fall to insure a winters supply of beef. Chickens provided eggs and many a Sunday dinner. Ollie was born on the family farm

August 3,1882. Being the oldest girl, she was depended on most by her mother. The next girl, Nora Nevada, wasntt born until ten years later. Providing for the needs of hungry, growing young boys was a rewarding and full time job for Ollie and her mother. At twenty one years of age, she married George Milton Watson in Dallas County, Texas. It began to appear that raising young boys was to be her calling in life, as her first five children were boys. She was 30 years old when her first daughter, Imogene, arrived. In November of 1904 Ollie, Milt and their firstborn, Ector, moved with the Back family to Gray County, Texas. Her dad and brothers built the new family a house. Life on the farm in a new land began and soon three more sons arrived, Lawrence, Bela and Virgil. In 1910 they moved back to Collin County to farm the 160 acre Watson family farm. A son and four daughters were born here on the farm. School age children walked one mile to Kelly School. They were members of the Church of Christ. Milt's dad, Joel Brown Watson, Jr., was a gospel preacher and assisted in starting the church in McKinney. While visiting her family in Gray County in 1921 she gave birth to her last child, George Audree. At this time it was discovered she had breast cancer and she died February 27, 1922. She is buried at Hillcrest Cemetery in McLean, Texas.

NOTES for LAWRENCE WATSON

Lawrence was the second of ten children born to George Milton (Milt) Watson and Olive (Ollie) Audree Back. He was born June 5, 1906 in Gray County, Texas in "Pumpkin Ridge" later called Back Community, approximately nine miles north of McLean. The Watson and Back families were neighbors in Collin County, near McKinney in East Texas. In November of 1904 the Back family moved to Gray County where they purchased new land to farm.

In 1910 Milt and Ollie moved back to Collin County to live with Grandma Elizabeth Jane Smith and work the 160 acre farm. Grandpa Joel Brown Watson, Jr. was a gospel preacher and had a part in starting the Church of Christ in McKinney, the county seat of Collin County. He died in 1894 and is interred in Warden Cemetery near the Community of Weston. The Kelly School house was about a mile

from the Watson farm and this is where all the children attended school, as they reached school age. Ollie died February 27, 1922 and Milt died October 10, 1922. Grandma Watson made arrangement to place the six youngest children in the orphan's home in Canadian, Texas. Brother Sol Tipton soon moved the home to Tipton, Oklahoma.

Finding himself alone at the young age of sixteen he went back to McLean to be with his maternal family. He received so much love and understanding from his mothers family that he never left Gray County again. He lived with Grandma Back, Aunts and Uncles, working odd jobs in the community. He worked as a cowboy with Uncle Vic; made a wheat harvest with a cousin, Clyde Holloway. In 1928 a young driller named Jimmy Warren struck oil on the home place; not two hundred yards from his birthplace. It was the largest oil well ever drilled in Gray County. The headlines in all the newspapers read: "Back No. 1 Comes in a Gusher." Almost overnight Back Cornmunity went from a farm community to an oil and gas community, with oil related jobs everywhere. Lawrence learned the oil business and later in life was a driller himsehf, like Jimmy Warren.

July 16, 1931 he married a young school teacher, Oma Cecil Hinkle. He borrowed a car from his cousin, Ansel Back, and the couple drove to Hollis, Oklahoma to be married. Their first home was a one room portable frame bunk house at Uncle Bud and Aunt Matties farm.

May 29, 1933 his first son, Lawrence Michel Jr. was born. Dr. H.W.Finley, Aunt Birdie (Mrs. Johnnie R. Back) and Grandma Hinkle delivered the healthy eight pound boy. November 3, 1937 his first daughter, Olive Marie (named after his mother) arrived, with the same doctor and midwives in attendance, but a larger house was involved. They moved in with Uncle Charlie and his youngest son, Sonny Boy. While they were in town on a Saturday a tornado blew the roof off and they all soon moved to Milt and Ollie's house where Lawrence was born on the Kellerville road. It was near Back No. 1. and you could hear the engine pumping oil 24 hours a day. Two more children were born at this location. James David was born November 14, 1943 and VeM LaVon was born May 21, 1945. Uncle Charlie soon moved to Dumas to drill for oil. Sonny lived with various relatives in Back Community and in McLean.

This section of land was mostly grass leased to a rancher named Joe Bidwell. Space was set aside each year for a vegetable garden. 16 acres were farmed that included crops of cotton, corn, peanuts, maize, watermelons and cantaloupes. The farm was worked with two horses (Tony and Champion), a go-devil, cultivator and a onerow planter. Cows were milked twice a day, pigs slopped, eggs gathered and chickens penned at night from the varmints and coyotes. The children walked about a mile to the Back School house, where Oma once taught school, and later rode the yellow school bus to McLean to attend school. There were hog killings in the winter with neighbor helping neighbor; or in Back Community it was more like relative helping relative as the Backs, Roberts, Holloways and Crocketts were all blood relatives in some manner.

In 1947 Lawrence and Oma moved their family nine miles south to the city of McLean. A stucco house with electricity, running water and indoor plumbing were the main attractions. Lawrence continued to work in the oil fields, taking a job with Warner Oil Company to drill for oil in Chadron, Nebraska. The new home was located across the street from the elementary school, which created a business opportunity for Oma. She opened a small restaurant in one bedroom and sold hamburgers, hot dogs, candy, soda, etc. during the noon hour. Later when the school was moved she opened a kindergarten.

In 1957 Uncle Johnnie and Aunt Birdie moved to Borger and sold their home at 518 South Main Street to Lawrence and Oma for seven thousand dollars. Being in debt was a burden for both of them and they set out to get it paid. Oma went to work at Marie Foundations who had a contract with Sears to furnish ladies brassieres. Lawrence had joined a carpool of two Uncles (Vic and Jim) to drive back and forth to

the Amarillo Air Force Base as a heating and air conditioning maintenance man. At first the pay was not good, compared to oil field work but it was steady work with vacation pay, sick leave, insurance and other benefits that the oil companies would never furnish. At age 62 he retired with a Federal Civil Service pension.

During those 17 years they managed to pay offthe homestead, help all four children get college degrees and looked forward to enjoying their retirement years. Lawrence died in 1986 with a blood clot, about a week after having hip replacement surgery in Lubbock. Notes for OMA CECIL HINKLE:

Oma Cecil Hinkle was the 9th child born to David Washington Hinkle III and Sinah Catherine Romine. She had five sisters and six brothers. She was born approximately 7 miles north of Clarendon, Texas, January 26, 1909.

In 1912 Dave bought a 350 acre farm about six miles east of Clarendon, in the Lelia Lake school district. The Hinkles lived on this farm for 28 years and Oma attended school at Lelia Lake, graduating valedictorian of her high school class in 1928. Her childhood years were happy and eventful as many brothers and sisters went about their daily chores. In those days its was the custom to have everyone involved in the daily housekeeping, cooking and farming operations. Each child had his or her own special duties and was expected to discharge those duties with pride and perfection.

Two sisters, Stella and Ivy Dea, has already been offto college and had accepted school teaching positions. With their encouragement, Oma followed in their footsteps and accepted a public school teaching contract at Back Community in 1930. Huland Laycock was the Gray County School Superintendent. It was here that she met her future husband, Lawrence. He was born in Back Community and most of the residents were kinfolks some way or another. He was mostly unemployed, but worked as a part-time cowboy, oil field roustabout and any other odd jobs an unskilled and uneducated worker could find. One year he made a Kansas wheat harvest with a cousin, Clyde Holloway. July 16, 1931 Oma and Lawrence Mitchel Watson were married in Hollis, Oklahoma.

They would live in Back Community for the next 16 years. Four children were born to this union and some years later they would see them all graduate from college. What a wonderful feeling of accomplishmont that must have been for this couple.

In 1947 the family moved 9 miles south to the city of McLean. Up to this time Oma had been a ffill time

wife and mother. With all her children in school, she decided to open a restaurant. The McLean Grade School

was located across the street and serving lunch to

the school children was a natural. Later when the school was moved she opened her own kindergarten

school.

Later Marie Foundations opened a factory in McLean. They had a contract with Sears to provide womens

brassieres and hired many local women as seamstresses. Oma went to work at the factory sewing. Her two

daughters also worked part time at the factory during the summer months.

Lawrence had taken a civil service job at the Amarillo Air force Base and with her factory job they had enough income to buy a larger home at 518 South Main Street from Uncle Johnnie and Aunt Birdie.

Oma and Lawrence were married 55-years when he died in 1986. She still lives in the house where they raised their children, grew vegetable gardens, planted an orchard and enjoys the company of many friends and family, who come to visit. She enjoys playing games with her youngest daughter and still expects to win her share. Her favorite TV shows add enjoyment to her daily life. Generally she is in good health and looks forward to life with a positive attitude. This 90 year old Christian lady has lived an accomplished life of teacher, wife, mother, grandmother and recently great grandmother.
