ENTRY FEE is \$21.00 per entry, which includes the 50¢ AKC recording fee. Entries will not be accepted if received without fees. Make checks payable to CRDTC and send to:

TELEPHONE, telegraph, and *unsigned* entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies without the Agreement & Rules on the reverse side are not acceptable. *This premium list can be printed from the CRDTC Website: www.geocities.com/crdtc*. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

ENTRY FEES will not be refunded in the event of a dog being absent, disqualified, or excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the act of the Trial Committee.

NO ENTRY FEE will be returned if the show cannot be opened or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the CRDTC.

A RECORDING FEE of fifty cents (US\$0.50) will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the trial, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2)

BITCHES IN SEASON: A refund will be made for a bitch that comes into season after the Closing Date, provided the request is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate and is received by the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in the making out of entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT for any dog holding up a class. The owner or agent of each dog is responsible for the presence of their dog in the judging ring when their class is called. Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging. **Only dogs entered in the trial are permitted at the trial site.**

NO DOG may be permanently removed from the trial before it is judged except by consent of the Trial Secretary upon a Veterinarian's recommendation.

DUE TO SPACE LIMITATIONS, no personal chairs can be allowed in the gymnasium. Chairs and bleacher seats will be available.

No private exercise pens are permitted, but a crating area inside and an exercise area outside the school will be provided.

AGREEMENT

I(We) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline" and, if this entry is for an Obedience Trial, the "Obedience Regulations," have been made available to me(us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I(We) waive any and all claims, causes of action I(we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC-approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I(We) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I(we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I(we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I(we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

INSTRUCTIONS

[1] (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Rudy, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

[2] A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for the show or trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show or trial for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
