- **\$2**, see TWO DOLLARS.
- **13th Floor**, Team taking an elevator and unloading on the 13th floor. **300**
- **55, I can't drive**, Team car traveling exactly 56 MPH. **200**
- **6 Pack Rings**, TM cutting up 6-pack rings. **25** each (Filmquest supports our feathered friends)
- **6 String**, TM buying their 'first real 6 string over at the 5 and Dime.' **400**
- **99 Red Balloons**, Team in possession of 99 red balloons. **600**
- **Abbey Road**, Team recreating the album cover from the Beatles Abbey Road. **300** (+**100** for a Volkswagen)
- **Aerobics**, Team doing an aerobic workout (a formal routine) in a health club. **400**
- **Afraid, Very**, TM telling a stranger, "Be afraid, be very afraid." (disclaimer: It is considered bad manners to scare the shit out of your fellow man) **200**
- **Age**, TM guessing a stranger's age. Must show proof. **100** each – no setups.
- **Airplane**, TM flying a radio controlled airplane. **400**
- **Alarm Clock**, TM smashing a ringing alarm clock with a golf club, baseball bat or both. **400**
- **Alka Seltzer**, TM chewing and swallowing an Alka Seltzer. **300**
- **Altoids**, TM eating 25 Altoids at once. **600**
- **Alt-Trans Quest**, Team's official Filmquest vehicle (defined as the vehicle in which a team spends 95% or more of their travel time) is something OTHER than a standard vehicle (car, pick-up, mini-van, SUV, jeep, etc.). Filmquest encourages alternative modes of transportation. **1000**
- **American Pie II** A stranger in a marching band uniform saying, "One time at band camp" **400**
- **American Pie**, A bar full of strangers singing the song "American Pie" **500** (+**100** for: Drunks, or Drunk Irish, or Don McLean)
- **Amish Buggy**, TM riding in an Amish buggy. **1500**
- **Amish**, TM playing the entire day dressed as Amish – oh wait, that's been done – how about dressed as a Viking. **200**
- **Amok In Time**, Two TMs fighting to the "death" like Spock and Kirk in the Star Trek episode "Amok In Time". **200**, +**100** for the correct music (if you're a geek you will know the music).

- ❑ **Animal Slippers**, Entire team in those oh-so-cute enormous animal slippers. **200**
- ❑ **Animals**, Team feeding animals next to a sign that says "DO NOT FEED THE ANIMALS!" **150**
- ❑ **Annie**, Non-TM redhead belting at least the chorus of "Tomorrow." **400** (+100 if team joins in on reprise)
- ❑ **Ant Sandwich**, TM putting 6 ants on a piece of bread and folding the bread and eating it. **600**
- ❑ **Antique Road Show**, TM pretending to be an expert in antiques, working with a stranger on the value of any piece of junk. TM must claim that it is very valuable and give plenty of detail and a background story. **500**
- ❑ **Ants**, TM scorching ants with a magnifying glass. **100**
- ❑ **Ants**, TM with ants in their pants. **400**
- ❑ **Apocalypse**, Team proving that the apocalypse is upon us. **100** for something that just makes you feel like the end is near, +**500** for a plague of locusts, +**1000** for the Four Horsemen.
- ❑ **Apples and Oranges**, TMs comparing apple and oranges. **100**
- ❑ **Arcade Quest**, Team at an arcade posting the high score on a video game. **300** (+**100** for putting "FQ" in the game for your initials)
- ❑ **Architecture**, Examples of really bad architecture. **25** each
- ❑ **Arm, One**, TM whipping someone with one arm tied behind his/her back. **300**
- ❑ **Armor**, TM in a suit of armor. **1000** (for a real, genuine steel, authentic or authentic material suit of armor.)
- ❑ **Art Museum Fountain**, Team in the fountain at the top of the Art Museum stairs, again. Damn it! It's Filmquest. **600**
- ❑ **Art Museum Fountain**, TM floating around the fountain atop the Art Museum stairs in some kind of boat, kayak, canoe, or Jet Ski. **700**, +**300** for ferrying a stranger to the other side of the fountain, -**1200** for dumping your cargo at the first sign of Imperial cruisers.
- ❑ **Art Museum**, Team at the bottom of the Philadelphia Art Museum steps charging people \$1.00 to run up the stairs like Rocky. Must include a sign. All monies collected will be donated to PBS because we obviously need more culture. **700** (must collect at least \$4)
- ❑ **Art Museum**, TM at the Philadelphia Museum of Art asking a guide "Where are the nude paintings? Cause I'm really horny." **300**
- ❑ **Art**, Team buying art from a street artist (No crafts).Filmquest supports the Arts. **200**
- ❑ **Artwork**, A TM's work of art hanging in a frame in an art store. **400**
- ❑ **Ass Man**, TM shaking hands with a proctologist. **300**

- ❑ **Ass Over**, TM falling ass over teakettle in a public place. **200**
- ❑ **Ass**, A stranger covering his/her own ass. **200**
- ❑ **Astronomy Observatory**, Team looking at stars inside an observatory. **500** (+**500** if TM discovers a comet and names it “The Filmquest Comet”)
- ❑ **Atomic Fire Balls**, TM with five (5) atomic fire balls in his/her mouth for 30 seconds. **400**
- ❑ **Auction**, TM bidding at an auction. **600** (+**100** if they actually buy something)
- ❑ **Automatic Chairlift**, TM riding an automatic chairlift up a flight of stairs. **250**
- ❑ **Babies**, Male TM videotaping babies at a hospital nursery and while videotaping, mentioning something to the person next to him about how the kid looks nothing like him and he never trusted "her" and how he can't believe he's strapped with this kid for the rest of his life and it's probably not even his - you get the idea....**700**, +**200** for picking a baby of a different race.
- ❑ **Baby Back Ribs**, All of the cooks at an Chilies Restaurant singing about how they want their baby back, baby back, baby back ribs. **500**
- ❑ **Baby Blues**, TM flashing his/her baby blues. **50**
- ❑ **Baby Food**, TM eating a jar of baby food. Must be at least a vegetable. **200**, +**200** if it is a meat vegetable combo.
- ❑ **Baby**, TM crying like a baby. **100**, +**200** for real tears
- ❑ **Bachelor/ Bachelorette Party**, Team at a Bachelor/ Bachelorette party. **500** (+**500** for TM playing the roll of the stripper)
- ❑ **Backhoe**, TM using a backhoe to dig. **1000**
- ❑ **Backstage**, Team back stage at a concert. **500**
- ❑ **Bacon, Kevin**, TM connecting himself/herself to Kevin Bacon in some clever way that the judges will buy. **200**
- ❑ **Ball and Chain**, TM wearing a real ball and chain during five stunts. **400**
- ❑ **Ball Game**, TM buying peanuts and crackerjack at a ball game. **300**
- ❑ **Balls**, Team with the “biggest balls.” **100** (+**100** if team has the biggest balls of them all)
- ❑ **Banana Peel**, TM slipping in public on a banana peel. **400**
- ❑ **Banana Republic**, Employee of Banana Republic saying 'Yes we have no bananas'. **300**, +**200** if they sing the song.
- ❑ **Banana**, TM dropping a Banana from at least 10 stories. **400**
- ❑ **Bananas, Attack of the Killer**, TM at the grocery store, pretending a bunch of bananas is attacking him/her. **200**, +**200** for wrestling the bananas to the floor or slamming them into a wall, +**200** for kicking them once they're down.

- ❑ **Band, Has Been**, A sign in a bar or club that shows a band that use to be big and now is on the "Has Been" tour. (i.e. The 23 East Presents: Loverboy - \$3 cover) **200**
- ❑ **Bandwagon**, TMs jumping on the Phillies bandwagon. **50** per TM
- ❑ **Bank Drive Thru**, Team going thru a bank drive-thru and asking for lollipops. "No. Sorry. I have no transaction, but could we just get 6 lollipops. **300**, **+100** if Team was also laughing all the way to the bank.
- ❑ **Bar, Swim-up**, TM at a swim-up bar. **1000**
- ❑ **Barenaked Ladies**, Team with Barenaked Ladies. **2000** for the band; **500** if taken literally
- ❑ **Barking**, Team in the mall, barking up the wrong tree. **300**
- ❑ **Barn Raising**, Team helping out at a barn raising. **2000**
- ❑ **Barney**, A Big bouncer at a bar singing the "I love you/ you love me" song from Barney. **300**
- ❑ **Baseball Card**, TM on his/her own Filmquest baseball card. Can be made in advance. Card must include the team name. Make a copy for the Filmquest archives. **300** per TM
- ❑ **Baseball Cards**, TM holding an autographed baseball card of Jackie Robinson, Hank Aaron or Roger Marris. **300** each
- ❑ **Baseball Target Practice**, TM throwing a baseball through a window. (break window at TM's own peril) **400**
- ❑ **Baseball**, TMs having a catch at a supermarket with some kind of fruit. Four or five tosses. Must be done with baseball gloves. **300**
- ❑ **Basketball Net**, TM cutting down a basketball net. You need to wear it around your neck like the champions you want to be. **400**
- ❑ **Basketball**, TM drop kicking a basketball from the foul line into the hoop. **500**
- ❑ **Basketball**, TM making five (5) free throws in a row on a regulation basketball court from the foul line. **1000** (If TM makes 4 in a row he/she may quit before taking the 5<sup>th</sup> shot a receive **500**)
- ❑ **Bathing Suit**, A stranger trying on a bathing suit (not the actual changing into the suit of course, pervert) and telling Team whether or not they think they'll be ready to wear it by Memorial Day. **500**
- **Bathroom Reading**, see DOO DOO DECIMAL SYSTEM
- ❑ **Batting Practice**, TM hitting a pitched tub of Cottage Cheese with a baseball bat. **400**
- ❑ **Baywatch**, Team watching Baywatch in a stranger's home with strangers family. **800**
- ❑ **Beans, Spilling**, TM spilling the beans. **100**

- ❑ **Beautiful, Pa**, Stranger's keeping Pennsylvania beautiful. **200**
- ❑ **Bed & Breakfast**, Entire team in bed eating breakfast at a bed & breakfast. **500**
- ❑ **Bed Race**, Team racing 2 beds (that are on wheels) down a street. **1000**
- ❑ **Bee Keeper**, TM wearing a bee keepers outfit surrounded by lots of bees (no killer bees). **900**(+**1000** for a beard of bees, +**100** for a goatee of bees)
- ❑ **Beer, Case of**. Team having an entire case of beer with no empties at the end of the night. Limit 1 case of beer. **5000** (+**250** for cooler with ice.)
- ❑ **Beer**, TM in a bar drinking a beer with a beer bong right from the tap. **800**
- ❑ **Behind the Quest**, Team making a short video (ala VH1's Behind the Music) about their Filmquest team. Remember the subjects always have either an addiction, TMs fighting or hating their leader or someone stole all of the money. The BTM may be made up in advance if the team has a public world premier. **600**
- ❑ **Bell Tower**, TM in a bell tower. **500**
- **Belly Button**, see PIERCED.
- ❑ **Belly Dancer**, Each belly dancer. **500** (limit 3)
- ❑ **Belly Up**, TM bellying up to a bar. **100**
- ❑ **Belt**, TM getting a fatherly looking stranger to take off his belt and smack him/her in the ass. **500**, +**100** if he does that nasty sounding snappy thing with the belt.
- ❑ **Ben Franklin's Grave**, Team tossing a penny on Ben Franklin's Grave for luck.**300** (+**100** for playing the instant lottery immediately after the penny toss)
- ❑ **Bent, Get**, TM all bent out of shape or telling a stranger to get bent. **200**
- ❑ **Berman, Chris**, Team making Chris Berman like nick-names for each other. **100** each TM
- ❑ **Biceps**, Stranger flexing his/her bicep. Bicep must be at least somewhat impressive. **200**
- ❑ **Bicycle Cops**, Cops on bikes singing "I want to ride my bicycle" from the Queen song "Bicycle". **400**
- ❑ **Bicycle, Antique**, TM riding an antique bicycle with the really big front wheel and little tiny rear wheel. **800**
- ❑ **Bicycle, Tandem**, TMs riding a bicycle built for two. **650**
- ❑ **Big Brother**, Team proving that 'Big brother is watching'. **200**
- **Big Picture**, see PICTURE, BIG.
- ❑ **Bikini**, TM with a bikini made with an airbrush. Any paint will do. **1000**
- ❑ **Bikini**, TM, male or female, entering a bathing suit, bikini, "hot bod" or something similar contest (Must be a real contest) **1500**

- ❑ **Bio Diversity Quest**, Woodland creatures in their natural environment. **50** each
- ❑ **Biological Clock**, TM lamenting that her biological clock is ticking. **100**, **+100** if it is an Oscar worthy lamenting.
- ❑ **Bird Of Prey**, Video of birds of prey in the wild. **50** each, **+300** for one making a kill, yeah baby.
- ❑ **Bird, Cursing**, A talking bird saying dirty words. **400**
- ❑ **Bird, Talking** A talking bird saying "Filmquest." **1000**
- ❑ **Bird**, TM with a bird in the hand. **300**
- ❑ **Black Cat**, crossing the Team's path. **200** (**+100** holding black cat)
- ❑ **Black Velvet**, TM clad entirely in black velvet. **300**
- ❑ **Blood**, TM giving blood. **1500**
- ❑ **Bloody Mary**, TM looking in a mirror and saying, "Bloody Mary, Bloody Mary, Bloody Mary". **100** Candy man will also be accepted.
- ❑ **Blow Up Doll**, Team sitting in a restaurant with a blow up doll. **500**
- ❑ **Blue Light Special**, TM at Kmart announcing a "Blue Light Special" on Filmquest action figures. **900**
- ❑ **Boat House Row**, Team carrying a sculling shell at boat house row. **600**
- ❑ **Boat Names**, Team filming one boat with a dirty sounding name (not *My Wet Dream*). **500**
- ❑ **Boat Owner**, Team persuading boat-owners who are in their boats to sing "Row Row Row Your Boat." **300** (**+100** if they do it in a "round")
- ❑ **Bocci**, Team playing Bocci with some old Italian men. **300**
- ❑ **Body Wrap**, TM getting a "body wrap" fat-reducing therapy. **200**
- ❑ **Boitano, Brian**, Team deciding what Brian Boitano would do if he were here today. **100**
- ❑ **Bonbon**, Shake your Bonbon, Shake your Bonbon. **100**
- ❑ **Bond, James Bond**, Give us three made up Bond girl names. Here are a couple of names already used in the films (and I am not making this up): Holly Goodhead, Plenty O'Toole, Pussy Galore. **100**
- ❑ **Booby Scrapes**, TM receiving booby scrapes from a hair dresser. **600**
- ❑ **Book Cart**, Team being pushed around on a book cart at Barnes And Noble by the employees. **400**
- ❑ **Book, Judging**, TM at a book store, judging a book by its cover. **200**, **+100** if the book is by Pam Houston.
- ❑ **Bookstore Chaos**, TM making a prank call to a bookstore while the team and camera are inside the store attempting to video the employees reactions (TM making the call is outside of the store). The TM must tell the bookstore that he/she placed an order and his/her name is "Kososkoff" and the book title is "Stalin: First patriot of Russia". **700**

- ❑ **Boom**, TM lowering the boom. **100**
- ❑ **Boomerang**, TM throwing a boomerang. **50** (+**50** if it comes back - no vertical toss)
- ❑ **Born Yesterday**, Team with someone who was born yesterday (May 25, 2001). **500**
- ❑ **Boss, The**, TM in a retail store asking the “boss” to sing “Born To Run.” **300**, +**100** if the boss knows the words.
- ❑ **Bouncer**, TM feeling a bouncer’s muscle. **300**
- ❑ **Bowa, Larry**, TM pissing off Larry Bowa the Phillies manager. **1200**
- **Bowl Tonight**, see GREASE 2.
- ❑ **Bowling Jackets**, Team at a bowling alley trying on strangers bowling jackets (or team shirts). Team all at once. **100** per TM (+**100** for holding a bowling trophy)
- ❑ **Bowling**, TM bowling one frame like Fred Flintstone. **400**
- ❑ **Box Office**, TM at the box office of a movie theater, selling tickets. **500**, +**100** for saying, “Enjoy the movie” +**200** for saying, “That movie sucks.”
- ❑ **Boxing**, TM in sparring gear in a boxing ring. **1000**
- ❑ **Boys**, Team proving that boys will be boys. **100**
- ❑ **Bra Quest**, Stranger showing her bra while she is wearing it. **200** each
- ❑ **Bra**, TM wearing a whipped cream bra. **400**, +**400** for someone licking some off.
- ❑ **Bra**, TM's burning their bra's in protest. **100** per TM, +**500** if done in public and making use of Team’s bullhorn (+**300** for each stranger joining in, 3 max)
- ❑ **Brain Cells**, TM throwing away brain cells like confetti. **300**
- ❑ **Bread**, TM in a store poking holes in the stores bread. **200**
- ❑ **Breakfast At Tiffany’s**, TM eating breakfast at Tiffany’s. **500** (+**200** if TM eats a bowl full of Coco Puffs at Tiffany’s)
- ❑ **Breathalyzer Test**, TM taking a real breathalyzer test. **200** (+**400** if the police administer the test)
- ❑ **Brick House**, Team standing next to a brick shithouse. **300** (**150** for someone built like one).
- ❑ **Bride**, TM kissing the bride. **800**
- ❑ **Bright Side**, TM always looking on the bright side of life. **100**, +**100** if Team sings the Monty Python song.
- ❑ **Brink's Truck**, TM (driving) Backing up the Brink's truck. **1000**, **500** for only riding shotgun.
- ❑ **Britney or Christina**, Team getting a bunch of kids to sing their fave Britney or Christina song. **200**
- ❑ **Broken Record, Sounds Like**, Let’s break some records. Five (5) records (LPs) and be creative. **400**

- ❑ **Brother, Can You Spare a Dime**, TM putting a quarter into a blind man's cup. **200**, **-1000** if you take a pencil.
- ❑ **Bubble Bath**, Team luxuriating in a bubble bath. Calgon take me away. **300**
- ❑ **Bucket**, TM kicking a bucket. **100**, **+300** if TM kicks the bucket through the uprights on a football field.
- ❑ **Buckner, Bill**, Team getting a loyal Red Sox fan to publicly forgive Bill Buckner. **300**
- ❑ **Budweiser**, Team doing an original 'Budweiser True' commercial. **600**
- ❑ **Bulge, Battle of**, Team with someone who was actually in the 'Battle of the Bulge.' **500**, **+200** if he tells you what he really thought of Gen. Patton.
- ❑ **Bullhorn, Rent a**, Team having a bull horn for the entire game. A real one. **500**
- ❑ **Bullhorn**, TM using a bullhorn to yell to a crowd from the moving vehicle, "Hey good lookin' we'll be back for you in a minute". **300**
- ❑ **Bun In the Oven**, Team at a bakery filming someone baking buns. **300**, **+300** for a pregnant girl doing the baking.
- ❑ **Bunk Bed**, Entire team on the top bunk of some bunk beds. **300**
- ❑ **Burger King Fries**, TM getting a Burger King employee to admit that their fries DO suck and they don't know what Burger King was thinking when they switched the recipe. **300**
- ❑ **Burger**, TM eating a hamburger in one big bite. **200**
- ❑ **Bus Marquee**, Video of the word Filmquest on a bus marquee. **600**
- ❑ **Bus**, Team on a real, full size yellow school bus singing "The Wheels On The Bus". **300** (Video from outside with TMs singing out the window)
- ❑ **Bush, George W.**, A letter from George W. Bush wishing your team luck on Filmquest 2001. **1500** (**+400** if your team now has an FBI shadow, **+100** for correcting his spelling)
- ❑ **Business, None Of Your**, TM telling a stranger, "None of your business." No set ups. **200**
- ❑ **Busta Rimes**, Team doing a rap version of a Leanne Rimes song. **200**
- ❑ **Butt Cheeks**, TM taping a stranger's butt cheeks together. **600**
- ❑ **Buttons**, Team having Filmquest buttons made. **250**
- ❑ **Butts Cracks Across America**, TM standing in front of something historic with their exposed butt facing the camera. The idea here is to have your butt and the historic thing in the frame at the same time. **100** per historic place.
- ❑ **Buzz Cut**, Entire team with a buzz cut. (Video need not show the cuts so long as the team is buzzed) **1000**
- ❑ **Caddy**, TM caddying for a stranger at a real county club. No public courses. **1000** (**+100** for an unsolicited tip)



- ❑ **Camden Yards**, Team inside Camden Yards. **1500**
- **Camera Off**, see TURN OFF THAT CAMERA.
- ❑ **Candle, Holding A**, TM holding a candle to something you can't hold a candle to. **150**
- ❑ **Candy Basket**, TMs distributing free candy to at least 10 strangers, telling each one "Thanks for being you." **25** per stranger, limit 25 strangers.
- ❑ **Candy Store**, A kid in a candy store. **100**, **+100** if TM he/she buys a piece of candy for a penny.
- ❑ **Car Art**, Team redecorating the team vehicle with washable paints. Car must have substantial decoration. **1000**, **+100** for a flame down the side.
- ❑ **Car Carrier**, Team car on a car carrier truck. **1000** (all the way on)
- ❑ **Car Dealership**, Team having a car dealer put a front plate (with the dealerships name) on the team car. **500**
- ❑ **Car Full o' Strangers**, Team vehicle filled with as many strangers and TMs that the team can swing. **50** per person
- ❑ **Car Load**, Video of a car with it's load not properly tied down. **200**
- ❑ **Car Purchase**, TM buying a car. A real car. **1500**
- ❑ **Car Wash**, Washing a stranger in a car wash. Must include the scrubby brush. **900**
- ❑ **Car**, Video of a car with different color pieces like it was made from leftover cars. **200**
- ❑ **Card Trick**, Stranger doing a card trick. **200**
- ❑ **Carnival**, TM operating a ride at a carnival. **800**
- ❑ **Casey at the Bat**, TM doing a dramatic reading of "Casey at the Bat" in Casey's Bar. Required: an audience of five. **200**
- ❑ **Cat Food**, TM eating a Tablespoon of wet cat food-because you, too, crave beef, chicken, and seafood. And no, tuna is not cat food. **500**
- ❑ **Cats and Dogs**, Video of cats and dogs fighting. **400**
- ❑ **Celebrity Filmquest**, Team asking a celebrity to join their Filmquest team. (i.e. "Excuse me Ken Griffey Jr., would you like to play on our Filmquest team"? ) **1500**
- ❑ **Celebrity Look-A-Likes**, TM approaching a celebrity look-a-like and insisting that they are talking to the REAL celebrity even after the person says it's not them. **500** (They must have some resemblance)
- **Celebrity Quest**, see Attached Sheet.
- ❑ **Cement**, TM writing Filmquest in wet cement. **900**
- ❑ **Century 21**, TM in Century 21 Blazer. **250** per TM (all at once)

- ❑ **Chadsford Winery**, TM asking the Sommelier to compare and contrast the wine of Chadesford with Mad Dog. **500, +300** if you can get the sommelier to actually drink the Mad Dog.
- ❑ **Chain Gang, Working On The**, Team getting highway construction crew to sing Chain Gang. **350**
- ❑ **Chair Lift**, TM on a chair lift. **200**
- ❑ **Chair**, TM throwing a full sized folding chair through the uprights on a football field for three points. **25** per yard, the goal-line is 10 yards.
- ❑ **Chalk Mural**, Team beautifying the shopping district with a lovely chalk mural on the sidewalk. **250, +500** if mob rule believes the art is truly artistic.
- ❑ **Charity Quest**, It's high time FQ went legit and really raised some money or a charity. Your team will get points per dollar raised in FQ sponsorships for a legitimate charity. Must show photocopies of checks made out to the charity, no single donation more than \$50, and have a letter from the charity acknowledging what you're doing. **5** points per dollar raised. **2000** max.
- ❑ **Check Cashing**, Team chalking (the bigger the better): "Loan Sharks Prey On Suckers" on the sidewalk in front of any check-cashing outlet and/or Rent-to-Own store. **500, +300** for also writing it with soap on the place's windows.
- ❑ **Checkered Flag**, TM taking the checkered flag. **100**
- ❑ **Cheerleaders**, Video of cheerleaders in full dress doing a Filmquest cheer. **500**
- **Cheers Theme**, See NICK'S BAR AND GRILL.
- ❑ **Cheese Steaks**, TM grilling up some cheese steaks in a restaurant for the team to eat. **600**
- ❑ **Cheeze Wiz**, TM eating a Cheeze Wiz and sweet tart sandwich. **300**
- **Chefs Hat**, see RESTAURANT.
- ❑ **Cherries**, Life is a bowl of cherries. **100, +100** if we see the pits.
- ❑ **Chess**, Strangers playing Speed Chess in a park. **300**

- ❑ **Dragons Lair**, Team playing Dragons Lair -arcade style. **500** (+**1000** points for slaying the dragon)
- ❑ **Draw Bridge**, the opening or closing of a drawbridge. **100** (+**1000** if TM operates the drawbridge)

- Endangered Species**, film of an endangered species. **300 (+200** for the Bald Eagle, Filmquest is patriotic)
- Ends Justify the Means**, Team confessing another Filmquest cheat. **300**
- Envelope**, Team pushing the envelope. **200, +1000** if the team breaks the sound barrier.
- Evil Knievel**, TM jumping toy cars with a ramp and bicycle. **300, +100** for a helmet , Filmquest is responsible.
- Evil**, TM choosing the lesser of two (2) evils. **100**
- Ex Girlfriend**, TM introducing a non-TM ex girlfriend to filmquest. No Stalking please. **400 (+100** if you are not really on speaking terms) Ex Boyfriend will also be accepted.
- Existence**, TM justifying his/her existence. **100**

- ❑ **Ex-lover**, TM telling an ex-lover exactly what they think of them, just for the record. **400** No Filmquestors.

- ❑ **Festival of Fountains**, Team at the Festival of Fountains at Longwood Gardens. **400**
- ❑ **Fetch**, TM playing Fetch with a stranger. **400**, **+300** if the stranger picks up the ball or stick with only their mouth and returns it to the thrower. **+300** if the TM rewards the stranger with a doggie treat.

- ❑ **Fiddle**, TM playing second fiddle. **300**, +100 for also playing the fiddler.
- ❑ **Fife and Drum Corps**, Fife & drum corps fife and drumming. **300** (+100 if you can get 'em to play a Beatles tune)
- ❑ **Fight Club**, TM telling a stranger, "I want you to hit me as hard as you can." **300**, +500 if they do.

- ❑ **Fine Print**, TM reading the fine print. **100**
- ❑ **Fire Escape**, TM racing up five (5) flights of an outdoor fire escape. **500**
- ❑ **Fire Hose**, Team spraying a fire hose. Yes, a real damn fire hose from a truck or hydrant pump. **700**, +200 for knocking down a TM.
- ❑ **Fire Truck**, TM driving a big fire truck. **800**
- **Fire, Juggling**, see JUGGLING
- ❑ **Fire**, Team starting a fire without matches, lighter, etc. (a la Survivor). **400**
- ❑ **Firestone**, Team finding Firestone ATX tires on a Ford Explorer. **400**, +100 for handing the owner a copy of the Firestone "Making It Right" promotional materials (available at [www.firestone.com](http://www.firestone.com)). Filmquest looks out for the safety of others.
- ❑ **Fireworks**, Professional fireworks. **200**
- ❑ **First Union**, TM in First Union Bank asking 'if this is the "FU" bank. No do you get it..."FU".....The "FU" bank...get it. Get it?' **300**
- ❑ **Fish or Cut Bait**, TM fishing or cutting bait. **200**

- **Flanders, Ned**, see HIDLEY HO.
- ❑ **Flattery, Empty**, TM giving a stranger 'alot of empty flattery'. **200**
- ❑ **Flesh**, Press the flesh. **100**
- ❑ **Flies On Shit**, Video of you know what. **100**
- ❑ **Flour**, TM eating a ☞ cup of flour without a beverage for assistance. **500** two minutes max (+**500** if it is done in one minute)
- ❑ **Fly Down**, Team finding a stranger with their "Barn door open." **200** (+**200** for zipping it for the stranger)
- ❑ **Flyers**, Each poor soul wearing a Philadelphia Flyers shirt. **50** each
- ❑ **Flyers**, Something about the Flyers that doesn't suck. **100**
- ❑ **Food Court**, One TM trying a food sample from EVERY restaurant in a mall food court. Team may collect the samples off-camera on a tray but it better be obvious that you have ALL of the needed samples. **1000** You must prove that you have a sample from ALL of the restaurants. Nothing under 10 restaurants is a food court.
- ❑ **Food Fight**, Team in a food fight. Must include mashed potatoes. **500** (+**500** for another playing against another team)
- ❑ **Food Stamps**, TM paying for food with food stamps. **500**, +**300** if the TM buys something that is so NOT a necessity like Doritos.
- ❑ **Foolish**, TM being young and foolish. **100**
- ❑ **Football**, TM throwing a football through a tire swing. **300**
- ❑ **Fore**, TM screaming 'Fore,' as they pass golfers on a golf course. **200** (+**300** for using a bullhorn)
- ❑ **Forever Young**, Team singing the song "Forever Young" in the team vehicle. Team may play the original song for help. **200**, -**1000** if any TM says that he/she is getting too old for Filmquest.
- ❑ **Forked Tongue**, TM lying through his/her teeth to get a stranger to do something for he/she. **200**
- ❑ **Fosters**, TM shotgunning a Fosters. The BIG one (a.k.a. an Oil Can). **500**, +**300** if you do it at the end of the day, and the fasting (see Filmquest Fast) TM does it.
- ❑ **Fountain**, TM swimming around in a fountain while using a snorkel. **400**, +**200** for flippers
- ❑ **Four-Leaf Clover**, TM holding a four-leaf clover. **200** (+**100** for singing "I'm Looking Over a Four Leaf Clover")
- ❑ **Franklin Field**, TM running the track at Franklin Field. **500**
- ❑ **Franklin, Benjamin**, Official Philadelphia Ben Franklin saying "Filmquest-it's electric!" **1500**
- ❑ **Freakin' Mark**, TM leaving his/her freakin' mark. **100**
- ❑ **Fredericks**, Male TM asking for job application for Frederick's of

Hollywood. **200**

- ❑ **Free Lunch**, There's no such thing as a free lunch. TM proving this old yarn wrong. **400**
- ❑ **Free**, The best things in life are free. Team convincing a grocery store clerk to give them a box of life cereal for free. **400**
- ❑ **Friday's**, Employees of T.G.I. Fridays singing "I Don't Like Mondays". **500**
- ❑ **Frog Legs**, TM eating frog legs. **400**
- ❑ **From Here to Eternity**, TM's rolling around in the surf making out like 'From Here to Eternity.' **800**
- ❑ **Fudge**, TM whipping fudge. **300**
- ❑ **Full Serve**, TM operating full the full serve at a gas station. Must include a checking the oil. **250 (+200** for TM berating the customer for the dirty condition of their engine)
- ❑ **Funnel Cake**, TM making a funnel cake at a fair. **600**
- ❑ **Futility**, Team involved in an "Act of Futility". **100, +100** for also an "Act of Fruition".
- ❑ **Gadzooks**, TM using the word "gadzooks" while talking to a police officer. Just work it in the conversation. **200**
- ❑ **Gaines Burger**, TM grilling a Gaines Burger and slapping it on a bun and eating it. Bon appetite. **700**
- ❑ **Garbage Truck**, Team hanging on the back of a garbage truck. The truck does not need to be moving. **200 (+200** for crushing some trash)
- ❑ **Garlic Milkshake**, TM drinking a garlic milkshake. Three cloves garlic, two scoops ice cream, two cups milk; blend until reaching desired thickness. Enjoy! And you must finish it. **500**
- ❑ **Garlic**, TM wearing a garlic necklace for the duration of the Filmquest game. **400**
- ❑ **Gas Mileage**, Team Vehicle that gets more than 30 mpg (some kind of proof is needed). Filmquest is fuel efficient. **200**
- ❑ **Gay Bar**, Team in a gay bar. **400, +100** if team picks up the support of the gay community.

- ❑ **Glam Rock**, Team dressed like and naming their own Glam-Metal Band from the 1980's. **400** (**+100** for a cool original spellings like "Ratt" or "Krokus") (**+100** for going into a club/ bar and saying "Hi!, we're the band")
- ❑ **Glamour Photo**, TM getting an allegedly "glamorous" photo portrait done at a Glam Photo studio. **700** (see also, TALENT AGENT)
- ❑ **Glass Houses**, People who live in glass houses shouldn't throw stones unless he/she is playing Filmquest. TM in a greenhouse, throwing stones. **200**
- ❑ **Glass**, TM blowing Glass. **1000**
- ❑ **Go Carts**, Team riding go carts all at once. **500**
- ❑ **God Speed**, TM wishing God speed to a nun or priest. **300**
- ❑ **Godot**, TM waiting for Godot. **50**
- ❑ **Goldfish**, TM winning goldfish at a fair. Fish must survive the gruel of Filmquest. **150**
- ❑ **Golf Ball Washer**, TM washing a golf ball in a real golf ball washer on a golf course. **100** (**+100** for a Bill Murray imitation from Caddyshack)
- ❑ **Golf Balls**, TM asking a golfer, "Can I wash your balls." **300** (**+100** for washing the balls)
- ❑ **Golf Water Hazard**, TM jumping into a pond on a golf course and retrieving a golf ball, no setups. **200**, **+800** if TM goes under water and retrieves a ball.
- ❑ **Golf**, Team finding a doctor on a golf course. (proof required) **600**
- ❑ **Golf**, TM taking a shot for a golfer on a real course. **500** for a good shot, **100** for a slice or hook.
- ❑ **Golfers, Heckling**, Team at the edge of a golf green heckling the golfers trying to putt. Must include 'Miss it noonan, miss' and 'Nnnnnnoonan, Nnnnnnoonan.' **400**
- ❑ **Good Luck Letters**, Letters from real companies that have Filmquest in their business name wishing your team luck on FQ2001. **500** each
- ❑ **Good Taste**, TM stretching the boundaries of good taste. **300**
- ❑ **Good, Let's Go Do Some**, TM doing an act of good will. Helping non-TMs. **150** each. Examples - carrying groceries to car, helping them across the street,

holding doors, etc.

- Goodnight**, Team singing "Goodbye To You" by Scandal at the end of Filmquest, just before turning in their tape. **200**
- Goodwill**, Team buying something good at a Goodwill store. **200**
- Goodwill**, TM's donating the clothes they were wearing at the start of Filmquest to goodwill. That includes shoes and hats (not jewelry). TM may use a drop box. **1000**

- Grave**, TM lying in an open grave. **1000**
- Grease 2**, Team at a bowling alley doing a choreographed dance while singing "We're Gonna Bowl Tonight" from Grease 2. **600** for an honest attempt.
- Greased Lightning**, Team in a garage dancing around car while singing "Greased Lightning" from Grease. Of course the original choreography is a must. **600** **+100** for cellophane wrap.
- Green Card**, A stranger with a green card. **400**
- Green, Tom**, Team convincing strangers that they are producers from the Tom Green show out collecting funny bits for the show. **450**
- Green, Tom**, Team doing something that would make Tom Green say, "Now that's gross." **500** **Lame** attempts will be laughed at and receive 0 points.
- Grindstone**, Keep your nose to the grindstone. TM with their nose on a grindstone. (safety point!!!! A spinning grindstone will take your nose off, as well as most of your face. Make sure the grinder is turned off.) **400**
- Grocery Store**, TM in an orange jacket at store helping customer to car. **500**
- Groovy Van**, Team in a really groovy van. **400** (**+100** to Team with grooviest van)
- Ground Pepper**, TM in restaurant/food court offering to sprinkle fresh ground pepper and/or Old Bay seasoning on their food. **600**
- Groundhog**, Team with a groundhog. **200**, **+1000** if it's Punxatawny Phil. **+500** for going medieval on his furry ass for all of the wrong predictions.



- ❑ **Guilty Pleasure**, TM playing a song that is one of his/her guilty pleasures. A song that you would never admit to liking except on Filmquest. **100** per TM
- ❑ **Guinness Book of World Records**, TM breaking a record in the *Guinness Book of World Records*. **1000**
- ❑ **Gun Shop**, TM asking the owner of a gun store why there is a waiting period. **150**, +**150** if TM responds to the explanation, "But I'm mad now!!!"
- ❑ **Gymnastics**, TM doing a round-off, backhand spring. **400**
- ❑ **Habañero Pepper**, TM eating a habañero pepper. **800**
- ❑ **Habitat For Humanity**, Team pitching in at a Habitat For Humanity site. **300**
- ❑ **Hair Cut**, TM giving himself/herself a haircut without helpful input from their team. **600** No mirror may be used. TM must follow the direction of other TMs.
- ❑ **Hair Dresser**, see BOOBY SCRAPES.
- ❑ **Hair Extensions**, TM getting hair extensions. **400**
- ❑ **Hair, Gray**, Filmquestors are getting older so we thought it might be time for a TM to "wash that gray right out of your hair." **600** TM must have gray to wash out.

- Horse Race**, TM placing a bet at a horse race. **500** (+**400** if horse wins)
- Horse, Gift**, TM looking a gift horse in the mouth. **300**
- Horse**, Team putting a horse in an office building. **1000**
- Horse**, TM leading a horse to water. **300**, +**300** if the horse takes a drink.
- Horse**, TM riding a horse with no name. **500**
- Hospital Gown**, TM in public wearing a hospital gown. **300** (+**300** for TM's ass hanging out)
- Hot Air Balloon**, TM at least 100 feet up in a Hot Air Balloon. **2000**
- Hot Coals**, TM walking, and we take no responsibility for this, across hot coals. **1000**
- Hot Dog, Vendor**, TM selling a street-vendor hotdog. **500**
- Hot Pocket**, Running a hot pocket through the bagel toaster at any bakery. **350**
- Hot Potato**, Team starting a rousing game of hot potato with the kitchen crew of any restaurant. The potato must be hot. **600**
- Hotel Shuttle**, TM riding from a hotel to the airport in a hotel shuttle. **200** Per TM
- Hotel Sign**, Team changing an outside hotel sign to read "Filmquest". This would be the sign the usually reads "Congrats to Tony and Sue on their marriage." **600**

- ❑ **Infamy II, A Date That Will Live In**, Video of Jenny Nixon calling Fred. **200**
- ❑ **Infamy, A Date That Will Live In**, Team getting a one (1) minute clip of the new movie Pearl Harbor for all of the Filmquestors to enjoy. **1000**
- ❑ **Ingenuity**, Team relying on ingenuity rather than money. **300**
- ❑ **Injuries**, Filmquest injuries that are not intention nor life-threaten. **100** each
- ❑ **Inside the Actors Studio Survey**, TM's answering the questionnaire that James Lipton (that pompous failed actor who

- ❑ **Juliette**, Team finding Juliette a new job. **500** (or **150** for a good lead)
- ❑ **Junkyard Dog**, Team with a junkyard dog. **200**
- ❑ **K.P. Corral**, Team showing up at bandstand in King of Prussia in cowboy hats asking "Where the hell is the KP corral?" **500**
- ❑ **Kahn**, TM yelling KAHN!! at the top of their lungs in public. **200**, +**100** for an aerial shot (like the movie).
- ❑ **Karaoke**, Male TM singing "Natural Woman" at Karaoke. **700**

(Kay's team will not get a look at the hair and she will not submit a guess....so that there is no unfair advantages.) The hair has not been cut at all since last Filmquest, it's just been growing since May of last year....since getting shaved. **300** for the closest team.
- ❑ **Kayak**, TM kayaking. **500**
- ❑ **Kazoo**, Team performing as a kazoo orchestra. **300**, +**100** if the orchestra plays the Glen Miller kazoo piece "In the Mood".
- ❑ **Ketchup Shampoo**, TM washing his/her hair with ketchup. **500**, +**200** for the green stuff.
- ❑ **Ketchup**, TM licking the residue off a bottle of ketchup in a restaurant TM must show the residue before he/she licks it off. **600**
- ❑ **Key to the City**, TM holding the "key to the city." **400** (+**500** if the mayor is present)

  - ❑ **Lacrosse**, Two TM's playing lacrosse in a church with collection baskets. **1000**
  - ❑ **Ladder**, Entire team on the same ladder. **200**
  - ❑ **Lady**, TM singing "She a Lady" by Tom Jones, to a female stranger. **300**
  - ❑ **Lake, Go Jump In a**, Team jumping in a lake. **300**
  - ❑ **Lamarr, Hedley** - TM encouraging other TMs on a stunt by crying out "Now go do that voodoo that you do, so well!" **100**
  - ❑ **Lamb**, TM shaking a lamb's tail twice. **300**
  - ❑ **Landry, Tom**, Old guy in a Tom Landry hat. **100**
  - ❑ **Lap Dance**, TM getting a real lap-dance at a real strip joint. **800**
  - ❑ **Laser Tag**, Team playing Laser Tag. **700**
  - ❑ **Latch Hook Rug**, Team, starting from scratch, making a latch hook rug that spells "Filmquest". No points if the rug is not complete by the end of the game. **700**
  - ❑ **Laundry Quest**, Team standing near a stranger's laundry that is hung out on a line. **300** (+**200** is the owner of the sparkling white underpants is standing in the shot)
  - ❑ **Law, Long Arm of the Law**, TM measuring the wingspan of a police officer. **400**
  - ❑ **Law, Ought to Be**, There ought to be a law against that. TM explaining to a police officer something they think

should be illegal. **400**

- ❑ **Lawyer**, Team at a law office persuading a lawyer to represent them (pro-bono) in case anything they do on Filmquest lands them in jail. **1000**
- ❑ **Leaf Blower**, TM drying a wet TM with a leaf blower. **500**
- ❑ **Leap Frog**, At least 10 people (team included) playing leapfrog. **500**
- ❑ **Lear Jet**, Team in a Lear Jet. **1500**
- ❑ **Lease**, TM getting a new lease on life. **200**, +**500** if the new lease has 4 wheels and a turbo charge.
- **LeBec-Fin**, see PERRIER, GEORGE.
- ❑ **Leftovers**, Team eating leftovers from a stranger's refrigerator. **800**
- ❑ **Leg Iron**, TM wearing leg irons. **300**, +**700** if it's at the county lock up.
- ❑ **Leg Up**, TM getting a leg up. **100**
- ❑ **Leg, Pulling**, TM pulling a stranger's leg. **300**
- ❑ **Legos**, Team building something very cool out of Legos. **400**
- ❑ **Leiderhosen**, TM dressed in Leiderhosen. **350**
- ❑ **Lemon**, TM eating a lemon rind and all. **500**
- ❑ **Lemonade**, Team buying lemon aid from children. **500**
- ❑ **Letters From a Nut**, TM writing a crazy letter to someone famous or a major company/organization. Think insane. **200** per TM, +**1000** if one of you get a response by the time we score the game. Example: Dear Mr. President, There are too many states nowadays. Please eliminate three of them.
- **Lewinsky, Monica**, see DRY CLEANER.
- ❑ **Lexus**, TM borrowing a stranger's Lexus. Quest in style. Team must leave one TM behind with the owner and drive out of sight. **800**
- ❑ **Liar, Liar**, TM kicking his/her own ass. **200**
- ❑ **Liberty Bell**, A guard at the Liberty Bell singing "The Shot Heard 'Round the World." **300**
- ❑ **Light house**, Team in the top of a light house. **1000**
- ❑ **Limb**, TM going out on a limb. **200**
- ❑ **Limit**, Team taking it to the limit. **100**
- ❑ **Limo**, Team arriving back at home base in a limo. **1000** (Filmquest has style)
- ❑ **Limo**, TM in a limousine that is parked at the top of the Philadelphia Art Museum stairs. **500** (+**1000** if the limo belongs to Sylvester Stalone)

- ❑ **Mail, Delivering**, TM delivering mail. (must be real mail and no taking it out of a mailbox and putting it back in) **300**
- ❑ **Mail**, Stranger opening his/her mail. **250**
- ❑ **Major League Baseball**, Team receiving the written permission of Major League Baseball to do anything. **1500**
- **Make Way For Duckling**, see DUCKS.

- ❑ **Mayor**, Any Mayor declaring May 26, 2001 Official Filmquest Day. **500**
- ❑ **McDonald, Ronald**, Team with the "real" Ronald McDonald clown. **400**, +**1000** If they can get him to say, "Someone please kill me."
- ❑ **McDonalds Fries**, Team getting McDonalds to give a happy meal box full of fries to the team. This is a twofold plan. McDonalds fries are the best and the team needs nourishment. **600** Team may not buy a ton of fries and dump the fries into the happy meal box.
- **McWilliams, John**, see REVENGE.
- ❑ **Mealworm**, TM eating a mealworm. **800**
- ❑ **Mechanical Bull**, TM sitting on a mechanical bull. **250** (+**800** if TM is riding the bull)
- ❑ **Media Attention**, TM getting any media attention. (points determined by mob rule)
- ❑ **Mermaid**, TM on a golf course buried in sand with a mermaid tail **300** (+**200** if TM tells other golfers to

play through).

- Merry-Go-Round**, Team being spun on a playground merry-go-round while singing "You Spin Me Round" by Dead or Alive. **200**
- Metalheads**, Metalheads saying, "John Tesh Rules!" **50** each (limit 5)
- Mettalica**, TM downloading a Mettalica song from Napster. **300**, +**200** for a bogus Mettalica T-shirt.
- Mickey Rooney**, TM kissing the head of Mickey Rooney (Mickey sold his soul to the now defunct Tabas Hotel. There are still billboards all over the place) **400** (+**100** if team says something like "Let's put on a show...")
- Midgets!** **50** each
- Mile High Club**, TM's joining the mile high club. **2000**, -1500 for entering the People's Republic of China's air space and causing a diplomatic incident, all for the sake of some nookie.
- Mileage**, For statistical purposes Filmquest will reward teams who travel far. **1** point per mile. (must show mileage on video -before/after)
- Military Tattoos**, Strangers military Tattoo. (1 for each : Army, Navy, Airforce, Marines) **50** each (double points for a Monopoly of armed forces)
- Milk**, TM drinking a gallon of milk in one hour. To Film: Video needs to show TM drinking 16 eight ounce glasses of milk (mmm milky). **1000**
- Millionaire**, TM playing the Millionaire game at McDonalds. TM must say on camera that they will split the million with all Filmquest players. **200** each TM with a correct answer. No points if any TM says, "Is that your final answer?"
- Mini Dress**, TM wearing a mini dress made of saran wrap. **300**, +**200** for clear wrap.
- Mini Golf**, TM hitting a golf ball through a moving windmill on a mini golf course. Each TM takes one shot. **500** if anyone sinks it.
- Minor League Park**, Team inside any minor league baseball park. **800**

- Monkees**, Team getting patrons of the zoo to sing "The Monkees" theme in the primate house. **400**, +**300** for assistance from zookeeper Scott Bartow.
- Monkey**, TM holding a live monkey. **1000** (+**200** for spanking the monkey)
- Monolith**, Team secretly placing a monolith in a public location. Must use

- the exact ratio 1 to 4 to 9. **600**
- Monster truck**, team in a monster truck. **700**
  - Moon Bounce**, TM on a Moon Bounce (FQ is bouncy) **300**
  - Moon**, TM proving that man never landed on the moon. **200** for cogent argument, **+800** for physical evidence, **+1000** for an “outtakes” reel with Neil Armstrong falling off the ladder or announcing, “That’s one small step for my winky”.
  - Mooning**, TMs mooning (all at once) for a picture in one of those photo booths. **250** per ass
  - Moose Crossing**, A moose crossing sign. **100**
  - Moral Attitude**, A stranger with a casual moral attitude. **300**
  - Moral**, TM being moral when it suits them. **200**
  - Morgue**, TM in a morgue drawer. **600**
  - Mosh Pit Construction Kit**, TM riding on top of a crowd in a team made mosh pit. **500** (+**50** for each stranger in the pit.
  - Motel 6**, TM turning a light OFF at a Motel 6. **300**
  - Motel, Welcome**, A motel signs welcoming Filmquest. **500**
  - Mother May I**, Team engaging strangers in a friendly game of *Mother May I*. **200** (This is only exhibition Mother May I – NO Wagering please!)
  - Moths**, TM sucking up moths with a vacuum cleaner. **400**
  - Motorist, Stranded**, Team assisting a stranded motorist. **300**
  - Mountain**, Team on a mountain. Must be over 1000 feet and the team must be within 200 feet of the summit. Filmquest is aesthetic after all. **1000** You will need to prove the elevation.
  - Movie Quotes**, TM quoting from any movie and seeing if another TM can figure it out. **10** each
  - Movie Theater**, Team getting a theater to put the word "Filmquest" on their board listing all of the current showings. (no drive-ins) **900**
  - Movie**, See BIG TIME DIRECTOR.
  - MST3K**, Three (3) TMs imitating "Mystery Science Theater 3000" in an actual movie theater with movie showing. **1000**
  - MTV**, Team watching MTV and actually seeing a music video. **300**
  - Mud Mask**, TM wearing one of those mud masks in public. **400**, **+200** for asking a stranger the time.
  - Mud Wrestling**, TM mud wrestling. **800**
  - Mud**, TM playing in the mud a la Woodstock. **400**, **+300** for a giant mud slide.
  - Muffin Man**, TM asking a stranger "Do you know the Muffin Man? He lives on

Dreary.” **300**

- Nick's Bar And Grill**, Entire piano bar singing the cheers theme (must include someone playing song on piano). **800** (210 W. Rittenhouse)

- No Woman No Cry**, Video of a woman the team does not know crying. Team is not permitted to cause said woman to

  - ❑ **Omelet, Insect**, TM making and eating an "insect omelet." The ingredients may vary (couple of eggs, cheese, whatever) so long as the TM kicks it up a notch with some insects. A TM or the team must eat it. **600, +900** if made in a real restaurant.
  - ❑ **One Thing Leads to Another**, Do what you say, say what you mean, one thing leads to another. **100**
  - ❑ **One-Night Stand**, TM asking strangers at a bar if they're on a one-night stand. **300**
  - **Open Faced Club Sand Wedge**, See GOLF.
  - ❑ **Open Space**, Video of a space in Chester County that a house has not yet been constructed on. **200**
  - ❑ **Opening Credits**, Team opens their video with some sort of credits for their team members, like a TV show. Must be set to really cool theme music (which does not have to be original). **500** (**+500** if the video has closing credits also)
  - ❑ **Orchestra**, TM conducting a real orchestra. **700**
  - ❑ **Other Teams**, each other team videoed. **200** (Not counting on home base or within one half hour of start or end of Filmquest.)
  - ❑ **Others**, Team doing unto others as you would have others do unto themselves. **300**
  - ❑ **Outer Space**, TM touching anything that has been in outer space. **500**(**+200** for also licking the item)

- ❑ **Outfit**, TM telling a stranger that his/her outfit is so five minutes ago. **300**
- ❑ **Oxymoron**, A really good example of an oxymoron. **200**(+**100** for a really good example of a moron)
- ❑ **PA System**, TM using a store's PA system without permission. **700**
- ❑ **Packing Peanuts**, TM standing up to his/her neck in packing peanuts. **700**
- ❑ **Paint Gun**, TM giving the team vehicle poke-a-dots with a paint gun. Filmquest is not responsible for dents. **800**
- ❑ **Paintball**, TM playing paintball. **500** (+**200** wasting a stranger)
- ❑ **Pajamas**, Team arriving at home base at the end of Filmquest wearing pajamas. **750**
- ❑ **Palindromes**, Team with a sign (not homemade) that includes a palindrome (no 3 letter palindromes). **100** per letter
- ❑ **Palm Pilot**, Team finding a way to put the Filmquest list in a Palm Pilot to do list. **400**
- ❑ **Palm, Greasing**, TM greasing a stranger's palm, literally. **500**
- ❑ **Pancakes**, TM in a restaurant flipping pancakes in a skillet without the aid of utensils. **600**
- ❑ **Pandora's Box**, TM opening up Pandora's box. **300**, +**300** for trying to sell it on Ebay.
- ❑ **Paper Airplane**, TM launching a paper airplane from at least 10 stories. **300**
- ❑ **Paper Cuts**, Accidental paper cuts. **100** each
- ❑ **Paper Sack**, TM fighting his/her way out of a wet paper sack. **300**
- ❑ **Parade, Don't Rain On My**, Video of a parade. **200**, +**300** if it actually is raining.
- ❑ **Parade**, Team car driving in a parade or Team walking in a parade. **800**
- ❑ **Pardon**, An ex-presidential pardon for something done during Filmquest past from Bill Clinton. **2000**
- ❑ **Pasta**, TM in a pool of cooked pasta. **500**

- Penthouse**, Team in a penthouse suite in a downtown hotel. **1000**
- Perrier, George**, Team shaking hands with LeBec-Fin head chef George Perrier. **1200(+300** If TM wears his chef hat)
- Pete Rose**, TM demonstrating the 'Pete Rose' slide (head first) into third. **250**
- PetQuest**, Proving pets really do look like their owners (or vice versa). **300**
- Phantom Menace**, TM irritating strangers in a mall. **350**

- Podunkville**, Team in Podunkville. It's up near Phoenixville somewhere. **300**

- **Pretender, The**, see IMPOSTER.

As an official Filmquest 2001 "TM" you are invited to help develop *next year's* Filmquest list. Any ideas are welcome and can be passed along to Kellyfilm Ltd. Or In My Pants Productions. We can't guarantee the idea will be used, but hey, look at *this* list—we're obviously not real picky.

Filmquest scoring is based on the Quest-o-matic™ scoring system. Quest-o-matic™ is an informal calculus based on five key factors: 1. Serendipity (how hard is it to find, how much pure luck is involved); 2. Peregrination (how far to travel); 3. *Chutzpah* (how much guts, courage, balls, breaking of a social mores is involved); 4. Athleticism (how physically difficult); 5. Aesthetics (how cool it would be on video). Everyone who plays Filmquest is invited to help score the tapes.

## Random Acts Of Filmquest

You see something, it's really cool, and you've got it on video, but *oh damn the injustice of it all*—it's not on the list. Not to worry. Now you can score even if it's not on the list. Yes, it's "Random Acts of Filmquest!"

Scoring will be by mob rule, made *slightly* less arbitrary by following the scale below:

- ★ = Kind of neat, I guess. **50**
- ★★ = Hey, that was neat. **150**
- ★★★ = Hey! That was neat! **350**
- ★★★★ = Wow! I can't *believe* you got that on video! **500**
- ★★★★★ = Un-be-*freaking*-lievable! **1000**

## PAPARAZZI ! ! !—the Celebrity Game

Once again, celebrity scoring is simplified into 3 categories:

- **Local Heroes** (small-time politicians and athletes),
- **Stars** (everybody knows who these folks are but they're not *that* big a deal), and
- **Mega-Stars** (everybody everywhere knows who these folks are and they *are* that big a deal). Should any Team encounter a super-mega star (Madonna, Michael Jordan, David Hasselhoff, etc.) additional points can be awarded.

There are three levels of interaction with celebrities:

- **Sightings**, celebrity is captured on close-up video, but does not interact with Team.
- **Autograph**, Team is able to get the Celebrity to autograph the Filmquest list.
- **Schmoozings**, Team interacts with the celebrity, who says the Magic Words—something like "I Love Filmquest!" or "Hello to everybody at Filmquest!"

The chart below provides a general guide for Paparazzi scoring. Celebrity scoring is flexible (*e.g.* Thatcher Longstreth is somewhere between a Local Hero and a Star; perennially-injured-semi-retired-sometime-All-Star Eric Lindros is somewhere between a Star and a Mega-Star) and can be worked out by the whole group while viewing videos at the conclusion of Filmquest.

# Filmquest 2001 Official Rules

1. If any member of your team is arrested, Filmquest shall disavow any knowledge of your existence and disqualify your team.
2. Filmquest 2001 will begin at 12 pm and end at 8 pm. If your team does not return to home base by 8 pm, they will be penalized: 100 points for the first 15 minutes and 100 points for every minute after that.
3. Players agree to the use of his/her name and video in any Filmquest medium without compensation. Players acknowledge that Filmquest will own & has the unrestricted right to use and publish any video submitted. All video tapes become the property of Filmquest Ltd.
4. ("The Dan Rule") Judges reserve the right to disqualify any video footage that they consider "cheating": example: Team driving a bulldozer. If your Team drives a toy bulldozer, it will not be considered. It is obviously not what we're going for.
5. Anyone playing Filmquest 2001 has a right to be a judge. Majority rules and all decisions are final. There is no Filmquest court of appeals.
6. Teams are responsible for their own battery power. (We recommend two).
7. The organizers of Filmquest 2001 are not responsible for anything that happens during Filmquest. You enter this contest of your own free will, and at your own risk. You and your team members are responsible for your own actions. It's only a game. If the Filmquest list told you to jump off a bridge, it's up to your good sense to know that you could be injured or killed. Every effort has been made to select things that will not get Filmquestors hurt, but it is up to you to know where to draw the line.
8. \$10.00 per person is the entry fee for Filmquest 2001. The team with the most points wins all of the money.
9. If it does not say "each", it is not.
10. Filmquest is based on the honor system. Violators will receive ZERO points and will be subject to public ridicule.
11. An extra 100 points will go to the teams for each item they complete that no one else does. Exception: each item will receive only one bonus. If you are the only team to jump in a pool and you did 100 pools...(bonus 100)
12. You may not complete any of Filmquest at a TM or relative of a TM's house, place of employment, or anywhere they have worked in the last year.
13. If you are going to a bar, your under age TM are exempt.
14. Filmquest is about interacting with strangers. Teams should not spend the day going to various friend's homes to complete the list.
15. Any one "stunt" completed may not be counted as two scores (i.e. If you hug the Mayor of Philadelphia you will get only the points for the hug and nothing for schmoozing a star).
16. The word "EACH" shall mean maximum 10 (unless otherwise specified).
17. A team may not complete a "stunt" where they have or are given a key to the building.
18. At the conclusion of Filmquest 2001 the video tapes will be watched in the following order: Completely new teams in random order followed by veteran teams in random order. No exceptions will be made.
19. Public means at least five strangers are in sight.
