Definitions: (all rates in US Dollars)

Travel: is calculated at either (ground) 25¢ per mile round trip from Ashland, Oregon or (air) coach round trip for 2.

Meals: are calculated at 3/day at \$5 each.

Lodging: economy room with queen bed + bath, double occupancy.

Multiple bookings: in same geographic area (100 miles), expenses are pro-rated and split between sponsoring parties.

Need any other programs for your event? If any of Jeff's topics are appropriate for another venue, he offers the second and third program during the same booking at only 3/4 of the regular price! Of course, you will have already paid his expenses for the first program, so you will save on travel, too. Think about adding a college class presentation, visit to your community group, a reception, a talking circle, a private or professional consultation, case staffing, a discussion panel, etc.. and take advantage of the discount!

Discounts & Scholarships

Funding sources are continually made available to groups who qualify for partial and full scholarships.

NOTICE: We currently have a private donor who is willing to match up to ½ of the full fee for a limited number of trainings or workshops (with priority given to the Four Circles Healing Process) that are booked and paid for before Sept. '05. In order to qualify, you must show that your group will use the savings to further wellness programming within your organization or donate the equivalent to a local wellness charity (ask us for details and book soon).

Groups/Organizations

Groups and Organizations that meet the following criteria may qualify for reduced fees of up to 50% off (for-profit and non-profit groups are equally eligible) :

The sponsoring organization must be one that has more than 50% of its focus on serving one or more of these Native populations:

- Native/First Nations communities,
 - children & youth,
 - addictions,
 - families,
 - victims of abuse/violence,
 - outreach/prevention,
- or
- higher education/continuing education programs that specifically address the concerns of Native People (e.g., psychology, Native lit, criminology/corrections, social work, anthropology, environmental science, music, Native studies, etc).

You will need to:

- document the population served,
 - local need,
 - plans for how you will use the discounted funds,
- and
- provide a history of &/or endorsements of your service to the Native community.

New projects & organizations will receive consideration provided they can support the other requirements for documentation (with the exception of "history").
