Kenny De Meirleir, M.D., Ph.D., is professor of physiology and medicine at the Vrije Universiteit Brussel where he is director of the Human Performance Laboratory and Fatigue Clinic.

Since 1990, Dr. De Meirleir has seen approximately 8,000 patients complaining of chronic fatigue at the university-based clinic in Brussels. He is a member of the board of directors of AACFS, the American Association for Chronic Fatigue Syndrome, and is board certified in internal medicine and cardiac rehabilitation in Belgium.

Dr. De Meirleir serves as editor of the Journal of Chronic Fatigue Syndrome. He has authored or coauthored several hundred journal articles and books on internal medicine, cardiology, exercise physiology, and chronic fatigue syndrome. He recently served as editor with Dr. Patrick Englebienne of the recent publication from CRC Press entitled: Chronic Fatigue Syndrome, A Biological Approach

Currently Dr. De Meirleir conducts research on the etiology, diagnosis, and treatment of chronic fatigue syndrome. In addition to his research and teaching, he serves as president of a medical disciplinary committee and on a provincial medical regulatory commission.
