Dear Quicksteppers....

Before President Anni left to visit her 98 year old mum down under, she whispered to me that I would have to write the April "Notes from Anni" for the Straight Shooter. Since I have a blank computer screen in front of me and no special notes, I thought that I would



change the format and share some historical "notes" as I recall them about your club.

Did you know that one of the Quicksteppers very first venues in 1986 was Audibon School in Foster City? As the club grew, it held dances in the small Audibon gym for a couple of years an occasionally at the Foster City

recreation center. Then the gym at Bayside School, Beresford Recreation Center, and St.. Gregory's Church gym were popular San Mateo venues for several years. We also sometimes rented halls at Temple Beth Jacob in Redwood City and Holy Cross Greek Orthodox church in Belmont for our dances and Birthday Bashes. Of course, just down the road is Twin Pines which has been another great venue for many successful dances, especially our "Glitz at the Ritz" New Year dances. Also, who can forget the countless nights at the VFW halls in Redwood City and San Mateo.

During the Country Quicksteppers more than 20 years as a club and the "boom" years of CW music/line dancing, the club enjoyed membership numbers in the 200-300 range. It was quite common to have 150 to 200 Quicksteppers attending a regular Saturday night dance. During those years of high attendance we were able to,

and needed to, rent large venues. Aragon High School and St. Timothy's gymnasiums in San Mateo were popular for large crowds such as the Birthday Bash and the Black & White Ball. Delicious pot luck dinners with many dancers in their country-western outfits were the highlights of the evening. Additional club highlights were the volunteer performances at the San Mateo County Fair and other events around the Peninsula.

During those boom years there were many popular DJs and dance instructors that included Don & Corrie Wright, Neil "the King" Hale, Mike & Noreen Gural, Mac & Jackie, Pat & Diane, Evelyn, Michael Barr, Jim Williams, Hedy McAdams, and many others. The boom years of CW dancing were very competitive, with the existence of many clubs and independent dance venues around the East Bay and the Peninsula. While there has been a dramatic change in CW dancing in the last five years, it is good to see the Country Quicksteppers continuing to provide an excellent venue at Barrett Community Center, along with the current group of talented DJs and instructors. The combination of these two things will help in maintaining CW line dancing on the Peninsula.

Thanks to Evelyn & Denny for another excellent job at the March 7 Purple People Eaters dance. And thanks to the 86 dancers from around the Bay who showed up for the fun.

Thanks to everyone for supporting Country Quicksteppers dances. It is great to see so many new dancers travel from all parts of the Bay Area to help maintain CQS as a strong club.
