Remember: The required vaccinations must be given within the time frame stated above. Please make sure you have this Certificate or an official Ohio Department of Agriculture Health Certificate completed & signed by your veterinarian with you at State Fair Health Check. Pet record cards, kennel records, computerized or other forms of vaccination records are not accepted. Your dog must also be licensed in your county of residence. Bring the license certificate to Health Check. Bitches in heat are not permitted to show. Check with your veterinarian several months prior to the show if you think your dog is due to be in heat during the show. Your veterinarian may be able to medicate your dog to delay estrus.
