

QF²D Questionnaire v.2.02 -- Concise List of steps to perform

1. Complete the "Personal Profile" Section with your data (questions #1, 2, 3)
2. Complete the "Professional Profile" Section with your data (questions #4, 5, 6, 7)
3. Fill out the list of the most relevant requirements from your own viewpoint (question 8): you can choose from 1 up to the total number of requirements expressed for the current project. Please, indicate each requirement with the code CMS-UR-xxxx (where xxxx is the progressive number you find in the requirements list)
4. Establish a priority level for the list of chosen requirements (question 8): after choosing the most relevant requirements from your viewpoint, please decide which should be their prioritisation on a 1-5 scale (5 means maximum priority, while 1 the lowest priority in the implementation)
5. Associate to each chosen requirement the relevant quality sub-characteristics (question 9): on page 2 you can find a list of 6 quality characteristics (the ones proposed by the ISO/IEC 9126:2000 international standard) splitted into 31 sub-characteristics. On page 3 you can find their detailed definition. On page 4 you must vote for them in this way:
 - § Take into account the first chosen requirements ("Req01" on page 2, question 8)
 - § Evaluate which is (are) the most valuable quality characteristic(s) to associate to that requirements (Functionality, ..., Quality in Use)
 - § For each one of the characteristics you have chosen, please evaluate which is (are) the most valuable quality sub-characteristic(s) to associate to that requirements (Functionality: from SC01 to SC05 – Reliability: from SC06 to Sc09 and so on) looking at the definitions on page 3
 - § Rate those sub-characteristics on a 0-3 scale (3 is the maximum rate and 0 the lowest one) and write the value in the grid on page 4 (Req01 column)
 - § Repeat all previous steps with next requirements (Req02 and so on) until the last one.
