



SIPSEY WILDERNESS TRAIL MAP
WITH LAT/LON GRID & GPS WAYPOINTS

GENERAL NOTES:
 No vehicles or bicycles allowed in wilderness area
 Parking space provided at selected trailheads (marked on map by "P")
 Self serve day use fee (\$3) collection containers at parking areas
 Wilderness area rules and regulations posted at parking areas
 Trail signs and markers in the wilderness area are very limited

MAP NOTES:
 Grid is compatible with GPS Receiver (Set on Lat/Lon, deg, min, decimal min)
 Datum: NAD 83. Lat lon data from gps receiver can be directly plotted on map
 Ground distance Between Each Major Horizontal Grid Line (red) = 1.15 miles
 Ground distance Between Each Major Vertical Grid Line (red) is approx 1 mile
 Ground distance Between Each Minor Horizontal Grid Line (gray) = approx 200 yards
 Ground distance Between Each Minor Vertical Grid Line (gray) = approx 160 yards
 Map distance between horizontal and vertical gridlines are equal for plotting conventional
 Lat Lon Waypoints provided at certain junctions and features
 600 & 700 foot Contour Lines are designated by numbers on the lines
 Area between 900 and 1000 foot elevations are designated by shading
 Area between 800 and 900 foot elevations are designated by gray hatch
 Boxed numbers on trails are distance in miles between junctions and features
 Blacktop vehicle accessible Forest Service roads are designated as FR, solid black
 Gravel vehicle accessible Forest Service roads are designated as FR, dashed black
 Official wilderness trails are designated by dashed colored lines with FT numbers
 Other Trails marked in dashed color but without FT designation may not be marked
 Routes marked by small black dashed lines from old maps & may no longer be visible
 Routes marked by dots are exploratory routes
 Rivers, Creeks and Branches designated by solid cyan lines
