

OVERCOMING FEAR

ear has had such a profound impact on my life. It is highly prevalent amongst novice Leather folk and those curious about the lifestyle.

It is paranoia about who we are and what we do that restrains a great number of those who fantasize about BDSM from doing anything more than dreaming or using the fantasy as a jerk-off tool. It is fear that keeps us from exploring, experimenting, and ultimately enjoying a fulfilling kinky life.

An authentic and viable Leather lifestyle cannot be built on the "lessons" found in one-handed reading. Hot stories are great for jerking off, disastrous for establishing relationships, learning correct techniques, and understanding the real dynamics of BDSM. Education disperses ignorance. It sheds light on the unknown, thus dispelling fear.

There are all sorts of fears, fear of rejection, failure, exposure, injury, discrimination, ostracism, and disease. In the earliest stages of any BDSM exploration it is the fear of the unknown that is most crippling. Fortunately, that is a fear that can be overcome.

One's entree into Leather usually begins with inner stirrings of desire and curiosity. Follow them cautiously and realistically. As you progress in knowledge of this lifestyle, you will naturally learn about yourself as well. You'll learn what you like and what you don't, what turns you on and turns you off. Emotions, fears, and doubts will come and go. Find some way to understand why this happens.

While I don't want to make a big deal about introspection, it can be helpful, especially when directed by a competent counselor. Retrospection, too, can help you see how you got where you are and what might need to be encouraged, what should be avoided. After all, even a "bad" event can hold a significant learning experience that guides us to really good events.

So take a deep breath, relax, and experiment one day at a time. Change is inevitable. The future cannot be stopped.

The Whitby Pride Association, a non-profit organization comprised of Whitby Gay, Lesbian, Bi-sexual, Trans and Two-Spirited residents, will be organizing this year's event.

The mission of Whitby Pride Association is to create a supportive community where the rights of Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Trans and Two-Spirited residents will be recognized and respected. We hope to do that by raising awareness of human rights through events such as "Whitby Pride Weekend".

"Whitby Pride Weekend" is intended to celebrate and support the contributions of GLBT citizens to the social and cultural fabric of our town and is open to all Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Trans and Two-Spirited individuals, friends, families, and supporters.

Events planned include a Pride Weekend kick-off party on June 12th, 2004 at a local establishment and a community BBQ in a local park on June 13th, 2004.

"Celebrating Diversity in our Community" has been chosen as the theme for this year's event. We have chosen this theme in order to promote the Town of Whitby as a caring, safe and inclusive community. We also wish to showcase how the rich ethnic, social and cultural heritage of our Town has been enriched by the contributions of our Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Trans and Two-Spirited citizens.

"This is an historic day for the GLBT community in the Town of Whitby." said Kevin Burke, President of Whitby Pride Association, and Whitby native. "With this positive support of our elected officials, and the broader community, future generations will look back and be able to trace the path of local GLBT acceptance and open integration." he added.
