CAMP RULES

- 1. No ground fires permitted. Use firepits or containers provided. Dump fire ashes in designated places only.
- 2. All garbage to be carried out. No burying or burning of garbage.
- 3. No cutting of any standing tree. Use firewood provided. All spare firewood is to be stacked.
- 4. Fire safety precautions to be observed at all times.
- 5. Stay within camp boundaries. Do not cross fence lines.
- 6. No campers will leave the camp without the permission of the unit leader and leader in charge of the camping event.
- 7. No visitors are allowed in tent lines without permission.
- 8. Employ good sense and safety in the use of axes and knives. Use of axes and knives is the complete responsibility of the section leader.
- 9. Acts of vandalism, carving of initials, damage to property will be dealt with severely.
- 10. Tojlets are to be left clean. Instructions and materials will be provided.
- 11. Do not throw garbage of any kind in toilet tanks.
- 12. Observe economy in the use of the fresh water from the main tank on the camp field.
- 13. All camp sites are to be left clean and tidy. Remember, this is no-trace camping.
- 14. Incidents of damage, faulty equipment and safety hazards are to be reported immediately.
- 15. No alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs are permitted on camp property.
- 16. Footwear will be worn at all times. Beware of hawthorns in the wilderness areas.
- 17. First aid kits and stretchers are located in the Longhouse and at the First Aid Trailer.
- 18. Camp Maintenance equipment, buildings, mowers, snowblades and tractors are out of bounds to all personnel, unless otherwise authorized.
- 19. Water related activities are prohibited except in instances where the Camp Manager has been advised in advance and the group has made arrangements in keeping with the water activity and safety regulations of Scouts Canada.
- 20. Leaders are responsible at all times for the health, safety and welfare of all the youth in camp.
- 21. No pets will be allowed.
- 22. Firearms, fireworks, explosives, flares, BB guns, air rifles or pistols, martial art weaponry, bows, arrows and slingshots are prohibited in the camp.
 Specific written approval of the District Commissioner or his designate must be obtained in writing at least 3 weeks in advance of your camp if you wish to use bows, firearms etc.
- 23. Supply vehicles may cross the "main field" staying to the high ground when conditions permit. If the field is wet, do not drive on it. Vehicles must return to the parking lot. All vehicles at the Longhouse must remain in the parking area.
